Enhancing Financial Access

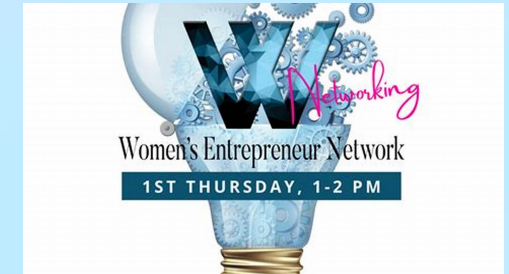
The initiative focuses on increasing women's access to financial resources, enabling them to secure funding necessary for business growth and economic participation, thus fostering overall development.

Diaspora engagement with policymakers promotes initiatives supporting women's economic empowerment in Ethiopia.

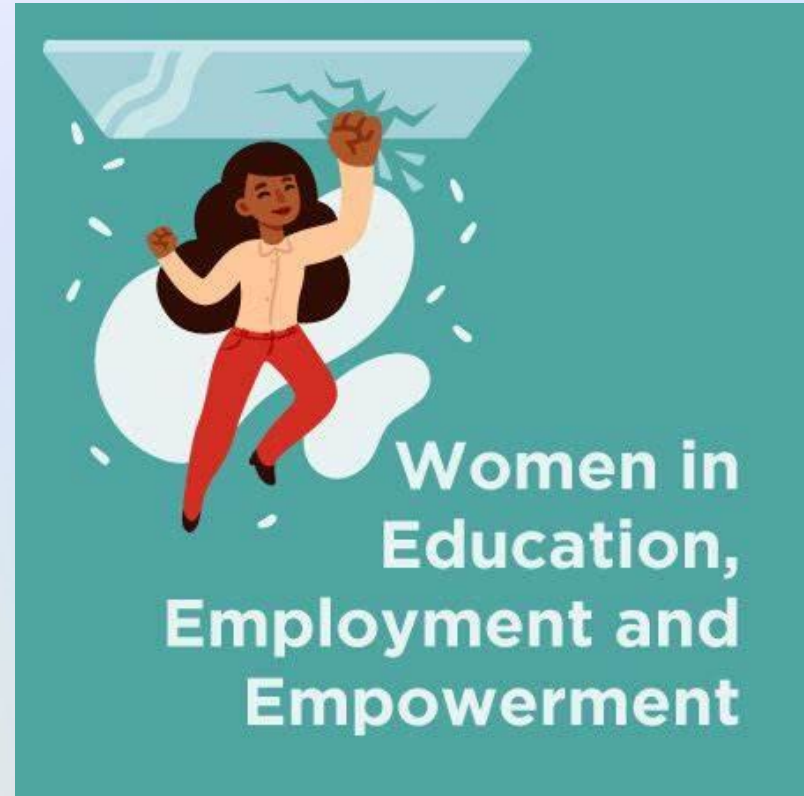

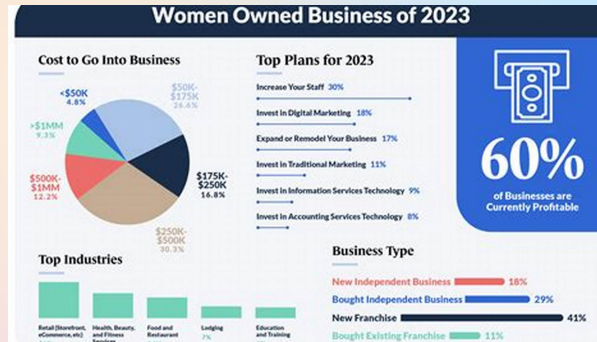


Empowerment through Skill Development
